UK Video Games Industry in Numbers:

Energising Business

- The UK video games industry is worth £6 billion in Gross Value Added to the UK economy.
- There are significant spillover benefits from games technology into sectors like advanced manufacturing contributing a further £1.3 billion to the UK economy.
- 3) There are 2,000 games businesses in the UK covering all stages of development, 55% of which are based outside of London and the South East.
- 4) 20% of games sold in the UK are developed in the UK. This is significantly higher than the European average of 8%.
- 5) In 2023 consumers spent £7.82 billion on video games, with digital sales amounting to £4.2 billion (up 3.8% from 2022).
- The UK is a key global player accounting for a huge 7% of the global market in terms of consumer spend.



Empowering Talent

- 7) There are currently 26,000 people employed directly in the video games industry in the UK, compared to the European average of 2,000 per country.
- 8) Each employee in the UK games industry adds an average of £113,000 in economic contribution - nearly double the national average.

Elevating Games

- 9) The UK employs 8,000 people in mobile games development, making the UK sector a market leader.
- 10) The UK recorded 985 Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) projects in 2023, up 6% from 2022, making the UK's share of Europe's inward market grow to 17.3%.
- 11) The UK is home to iconic IP created in studios up and down the country from Tomb Raider to Grand Theft Auto and many more:
